History – Identify all assignments for the week. Read assignment 1 time	History – Read assignment 2 nd time and annotate; complete reading log	History – Read assignment 3 rd time and annotate; complete reading log	History – review reading log; check to make sure all assignments are complete	History – look over next week’s assignments
